EVENT DAY – May 21, 2016 Playground Drive opens at 8:30 a.m. & booth set up must be complete by 9:45

Booth **TAKEDOWN** begins at 3:45 p.m. All Booth Participants must remain in place until after the closing activity.

Plan to stay operating your booth until 4:00 p.m.

**Thank you for participating in the Texas Tree Climbing Competition!
& Don't forget . . .**

Bring your own tables, chairs, wire, rope, tape, sandbags, canopies etc. to set-up or hang your displays and an electric extension cord if needed.

DIRECTIONS: The spaces will be reserved for your organization on Playground Drive. Please enter from Landa Park Drive and turn left onto Playground Drive. A Ranger will let you enter the closed space to drop off the materials for the booth set-up. Please quickly drop off the supplies & table and exit next to Monument Drive.
