TRAQ Renewal Class Registration Deadline is Jan. 24, 2020 Feb. 28, 2020, Waco

The TRAQ Renewal Course is a one-day refresher, with five hours of instruction, and three hours to take the exam. Current TRAQ holders can complete the course as early as three and one-half (3 1/2) years into their Qualification (18 months before your expiration date). If you received a

Tree Risk Assessment Qualification between February 28, 2020 and August 28, 2021, you can register for this renewal. Once your current expiration date passes, you will need to retake the full course and assessment to be reinstated.

Once you have successfully passed the renewal requirements, you will be given 5 years from the date of your previous expiration allowing you to take full advantage of the 5 year period granted with the credential.




