


### TRAQ Course and Assessment and Renewal Houston and Dallas


# 2022 Oak Wilt Vendor Online Directory Registration Registration deadline: Feb. 25, 2022


The Texas Chapter ISA has a new app on its website designed to let tree care customers easily find you and your services. They just type in their zip code or address and your firm pops

# Trees Mean Business! Poor landscaping can decrease property value by as much as 30%

According to a survey by Trees.com, 78 percent of real estate agents say poor landscaping negatively affects property values.

Around 24 percent of professionals say poor landscaping can reduce a home's value by 10 percent, while 22 percent say the value decreases by 20 percent. Another 18 percent predict a home's value drops by 30 percent or more.

The landscaping elements that add the most value to a home include grass (64 percent), trees (59 percent), and flowers (52 percent).

According to the survey, 91 percent of agents say adding just one healthy tree can increase property value.
